Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back everyone to the Summer Term, I hope you had a wonderful Easter break and managed to enjoy some of the sunshine which was scattered across those two weeks! May I extend a very warm welcome to our new pupils and their families who join our Ringstead Community. As well as the new staff who join our school team - Mr Elston - class teacher of Hawks and Mrs Riches, a teaching assistant in Falcons.

It is a busy term that lies ahead of us, with Year 6 SATs in May, followed by Year 4 Multiplication Tests in June along with Year 1 Phonics Screening Tests. A Year 6 residential at the end of this half term to the Isle of Wight, class trips to various places of worship including a Gudwara and a Mandir, Silverstone, West Stow, Woburn, not to mention the seaside!
