The school has spent a vast amount of money in trying to ensure that all pupils receive the same opportunities of reading at home, with or without an adult as these books are fully decodable. However, I cannot stress enough that simply listening to your child read aloud every day really does make such a difference to their reading ability and progress. Please also remember to sign their reading diary as if they receive 5 reads a week then they are entered into the weekly prize draw for a free book of their choice.
